

Mike's comments on Te Awamutu's Scorer's Guide .. offered in the spirit of helpfulness to all

It is to be hoped that with contributions, questions, and discussion that some light will thereby be shed on a few of the mysteries of Compass Scoring

Well done Nick - an easy to follow pictorial guide to basic scoring. My comments

- many other clubs have discovered the benefits of Scoring Assist Mode (SAM) which can be turned on so it comes up first by default
- users can toggle between the standard setup and SAM by clicking the pink button in either screen
- SAM displays and defaults to the current day's event from the Calendar then prompts for just two parameters - number of tables, and is there a phantom. With those two factors SAM punts up a list of appropriate bomb-proof movements to choose from
- not all clubs will have Role Management activated. Those that do often have password-protected roles enabled
- the first screenshot after AFTER THE SESSION should show a blank panel in Compassmate - a good sign that all results are in
- the Upload XML File to post to the website instruction is missing
- there is a popular option to email results to players - not turned on at Te Awamutu it seems
- at 20 the number of clubs using Compa\$\$ is increasing .. but Compass is running in 45+ clubs
- the Club Comps button in the results screen can be used to do ladders

Not sure that we could encompass all the alternatives that may be turned on at other clubs but at least clubs can cobble together similar Guides from the material presented here
