

# Director's Quick Reference Guide Pass Out of Rotation (Law 30)

The pass out of rotation has not been accepted.

Who's call was it?



LHO
(if offender hasn't already called)
or Partner

**LHO** (if offender has a ready called)

Call goes back to RHO.

Offender must pass on their next turn to call, after which bidding continues with no further restrictions.

Call goes back to correct player. Partner can make any legal call after which, Offender can make any legal call. When that call is a comparable call there is no further rectification (there is no UI). If offender makes a call that is not comparable, partner must then pass on their next turn to call. (Partner has UI and lead restrictions apply if they become defenders)

When a player, having previously called, calls at their LHO's turn to call, this is considered a change of call and Law 25 applies

## Director's Quick Reference Guide Bid Out of Rotation (Law 31)

Ref: World Bridge Federation Laws of Duplicate Bridge 2017 – Laws 29 - 32

A bid is a call that specifies a number and a denomination, or, for the purposes of this law, a pass with an artificial meaning or a pass of partner's artificial call.

#### The bid out of rotation has not been accepted.

Call goes back to RHO.

RHO passes - offender must repeat their bid.
RHO bids - offender can make any legal call. When that call is a comparable call there is no further rectification (there is no UI). If offender makes a call that is not comparable, then partner must pass on their next turn to call. (Partner has UI and lead restrictions apply if they become defenders)

Call goes back to correct player. Partner can make any legal call after which, Offender can make any legal call.
